**NATIONAL BOARD OF REVIEW FOR VENTURER AND EAGLE SCOUT  
ASPIRANTS**

1. In reference to Council Office Memorandum No. 2, s. 2018, the BSP-Negros Occidental Council will hold the National Board of Review for Venturer and Eagle Scout Aspirants on March 26-28, 2018 at BSP-Negros Occidental Council Office, Bacolod City.

**Note: Opening Program will start at 8:00 a.m. of March 26, 2018.**

2. The objectives of this review aims to:

- 2.1 discuss among the scouts regarding the value of scouting in home, school and community;
- 2.2 evaluate the scouts personality accomplishments and attitude toward scouting; and
- 2.3 encourage scouts to progress and develop themselves and to live the Scout Oath and Law in their everyday life.

3. The registration fee, food, transportation expenses of the Scout Aspirants and adult leaders may be charged against local funds/MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations set by law.

**Note: Registration Fee:**

1. Eagle Scout Rank - **₱500.00**
2. Venturer Scout Rank - **₱300.00**

4. The Qualifications of the Scout Aspirants:

- 4.1 must be currently registered Senior Scouts;
- 4.2 must be a holder of at least Outdoorsman Rank Holder for Venturer Aspirants; and
- 4.3 must be Venturer Rank Holder for Eagle Scouts.

**Note: Attire: Prescribed Type A & Type B BSP uniform**

5. All PSDSs and School Heads concerned are enjoined to support this life skills development program for the scouts/learners.
