

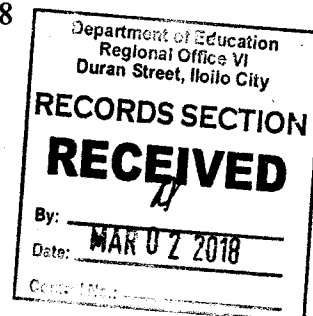

**GUIDELINES FOR THE OMBUDSMAN VISAYAS  
CAMPUS INTEGRITY CRUSADERS (CIC) JINGLE WRITING CONTEST**

**1. *Qualification***

Only accredited Campus Integrity Crusaders (CIC) Program Partners are qualified to join.

**2. *Mechanics***

- a) One or Two (2) entries per Division of the Department of Education (DepEd) in Region VI.
- b) The theme of the song shall embody the Values, Culture, Vision and Mission of the Office of the Ombudsman, particularly the objectives of the CIC Program.
- c) Every entry shall be composed of three (3) participants (interpreters), a maximum of five (5).
- d) The song may be in acapella or with an accompaniment and must not exceed two (2) minutes).
- e) The lyrics of the song may be either in Filipino or English.
- f) The song entry must be recorded on a CD and be submitted with a copy of the lyrics, to the respective CIC Coordinator/s in each Division, who shall endorse the same to the Office of the Ombudsman Regional Office VI on or before March 14, 2018.
- g) The participants shall declare that the song submitted is their original work, has not been submitted to any other competition, and does not infringe on any third party's existing copyright. Any complaints that may arise due to similarities, likeness or comparison of the song would be the accountability of the participant as they would be responsible to prove its authenticity.
- h) The winning entry shall automatically become the intellectual property of the Office of the Ombudsman Visayas.
- i) Failure to follow the specified guidelines would mean disqualification.

### **3. Criteria**

- **Musicality of the Material** - **30%**
  - Structure, Tone Progression, Melodic Catch of Hook
- **Lyrical Quality** - **30%**
  - Choice of Words, Propriety to the theme, Propriety to the Melody
- **Delivery** - **25%**
  - Harmony, Intonation, Balance, Interpretation, Arrangement
- **Mass Appeal** - **15%**
  - Can easily be adopted by the listeners and catches attention

**TOTAL - 100%**

### **4. Prizes.** Only one winner shall be selected. There will be a second and a third placer.

The winner will be given a Cash Prize and a Certificate of Recognition.

### **5. Announcement and Awarding of Winners**

The announcement of winners and awarding of prizes shall be conducted during the 3<sup>rd</sup> CIC Congress (schedule to be announced).
