- 7. Immediate dissemination and compliance of this memorandum is desired.



The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services - School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), will conduct a validation of the candidates for the Seal of Excellence (SOE) of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program per DepEd Memorandum 194, s. 2018 in the province of **Aklan** on **November 7-11, 2022**. This was originally scheduled on October 24-28, 2022.

This activity is in partnership with Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), and Save the Children Philippines (SCP) and aims to: (a.) validate the nominees/candidates of select regions for the first Seal of Excellence Awards of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program; (b.) update and capacitate the Regional and select Division WinS Coordinators on the proper way to conduct validation procedures as part of M&E mechanism of the WinS program; (c.) assist the participants on how to navigate and utilize Online Monitoring System and WinS dashboard for validation purposes; and (d.) share and highlight the best practices of schools in the implementation of the WinS program.

In this regard, this Office respectfully requests the presence of the 2 school-level representatives (School Head and School WinS Coordinator or Non-Teaching Personnel) from the candidate-schools to attend and prepare supporting documents as Means of Verification (MOVs) for the 3-star status of their respective schools (covering SY 2017-2018; 2018-2019; and 2019-2020) during the validation.

School heads may consider to designate a Non-Teaching Personnel in lieu of School WinS Coordinators to ensure that classes will not be interrupted. Select Division and Regional WinS Coordinators are also requested to attend. For details on the program and the participants of this activity, kindly refer to **Annex A** (Program of Activities) and **Annex B** (List of Participants from the Candidate-Schools per Region for the Seal of Excellence (SOE) of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program).

2. Check-out is on November 11, 2022 after breakfast;

3. Funds for traveling expenses of school-level participants from Region VI as well as any shortage in the downloaded funds is requested to be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations and

4. Participants are fully vaccinated and requested to bring their vaccination card. Health protocols against COVID-19 are requested to be observed. However, participants are discouraged from attending the activity if exposed to a COVID-19 positive or they experience any symptoms.

Further, the MOVs for the 3 school years are recommended to be placed in one portfolio which may include, but not limited to, printed WinS monitoring tool, photo documentation of the indicators, certifications (e.g. Water Analysis result, Certificate of Recognition signed by Regional Director), among others. A 15-minute powerpoint presentation of each candidate-school highlighting the compliance to the WinS standards and indicators should be prepared.
