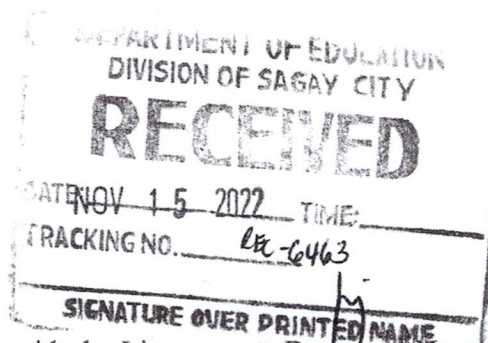

2022 POSTER-MAKING AND ESSAY- WRITING CONTEST

Theme: "Addressing Drug Challenges in Health and Humanitarian Crises"

**Contest-November 24, 2022
Awarding- November 28, 2022**

Guidelines:

A. Poster-Making Contest

1. This is open to all Junior High School students from any school or barangay in the province of Negros Occidental. They must be amateur artists – have not won any award in a national art competition. Winners from competition held in schools or among schools may join.
2. Each entry should be a collaboration of 3 individuals of the same school or barangay.
3. The participants must be at the venue by 8:00 A.M. on the day of the contest.
4. They will be provided one cartolina per group, on which they will render their concept of the poster based on the theme.
5. Acceptable tools in making their poster include pencil, crayon, pastel, water color, poster color, and marker pens. Photographs, wires, and other 3D objects are not acceptable.
6. The participants must bring their own tools to complete their entry. Borrowing of tools among competing participants is discouraged.
7. The poster must not include words other than the given theme.
8. The artwork must not represent any particular individual, organization, or brand name.
9. Each completed entry must not bear the contestants' name, school, or barangay. No contestant is allowed to use his/her school uniform or any piece of clothing that bears the name of the school/barangay he/she is representing. Only pre-assigned numbers will be used to identify the entries.



10. Participants are given 2 hours to finish their entry.
11. All entries submitted will become the property of the organizing team.
12. The decision of the board of judges is final.
13. Criteria for judging will be as follows:

Relevance to the theme	-	20%
Originality	-	20%
Creativity	-	30%
Color Harmony	-	15%
Visual impact	-	15%
Total	-	100%

B. Essay-Writing Contest

1. This is open to all College students from any school or barangay in the province of Negros Occidental. They must be amateur writers who have not been recognized by any national award-giving organization and whose work has never been published yet, except in school paper.
2. This is an individual event. Only a maximum of two participants will be allowed per school or barangay.
3. The participants must be at the venue by 8:00 A.M. on the day of the contest.
4. The participants will be provided 3 pieces of bond paper, on which they will write their 2000-word essay based on the theme.
5. All entries must be handwritten. Everyone is encouraged to write their final draft legibly so that the judges will not have difficulty reading his/her work.
6. All essays must be original. No part of the essay must be copied from anyone else's written work. The use of short quotations may be allowed so long as there is credit to the author. A bible passage may also be quoted so long as the book, chapter, and verse is properly mentioned.
7. No one is allowed to bring anything other than pens, pencils, and ruler to the competition area. The use of dictionary or mobile phones is discouraged while the contest is going on.



8. Each submitted essay must not bear the contestants' name, school, or barangay. No contestant is allowed to use his/her school uniform or any piece of clothing that bears the name of the school/barangay he/she is representing. Only pre-assigned numbers will be used to identify the entries.
9. Participants are given 2 hours to finish their entry.
10. All entries submitted will become the property of the organizing team.
11. The decision of the board of judges is final.
12. Criteria for judging will be as follows:

Content	-	50%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Relevance to the theme – connection, significance of the issue being discussed• Comprehensiveness – how complete and detailed the writer's exposition of the topic• Originality – uniqueness, novelty and authenticity of ideas• Insights – a fresh way of looking at things, critical view of the subject		
Organization	-	30%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clarity of Thoughts – use of simple and appropriate words to convey ideas or issues• Creativity – the use of appropriate devices and expressions in the exposition of the subject• Unity and Consistency – ability to highlight the focal point		
Mechanics	-	20%
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• the correct use of punctuation, capitalization and grammar		
Total	-	100%
